

Four thousand families randomly selected by a computer in all regions of Russia took part in such research in the end of last year. The goal of our work is to understand how the life of Russian citizens is changing nowadays. That is why we want to survey the same people now.

All information collected in the course of the research will be used only in synthesized form. No one, except myself and the organizers of the survey, will know about our discussion.

We understand that you will spend some of your free time on the interview. Besides this, answering these questions is, of course, work. Therefore, we will pay you as much as our resources allow.

Participation in our research is voluntary and you always have the right to refuse to answer the questions.

[ <u>ATTENTION, INTERVIEWER!</u> PRIOR TO THE FIRST VISIT TO EACH ADDRESS WHERE THE HOUSEHOLD SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED THE LAST TIME, OBTAIN A "HOUSEHOLD COMPOSITION FORM" FROM THE SURVEY ORGANIZER AND COPY THE NAMES AND PATRONYMICS OF HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS IN EXACTLY THE SAME ORDER FROM IT TO A FAMILY QUESTIONNAIRE CARD ON PAGE **4**.
